USING A MANDATORY VARIANT

A Mandatory Variant can be used if a particular Variant must be sold along with any other Variants of a Bookable Product. For example if a Childs ticket to an event can only be sold when an Adult ticket is purchased, the Variant of Adult would have to be marked as the Mandatory Variant.

SETTING THE MANDATORY VARIANT ON THE BOOKABLE PRODUCT FORM

The Mandatory Variant is controlled on the Bookable Product form. With the appropriate Bookable Product form open. The **Mandatory Variants** flag must be set to **Yes**.

When the Variants have been added to the Bookable Product form the Mandatory Variant has to be chosen. (This is the Variant that **MUST** be purchased, any further Variant can only be added if the Mandatory Variant has been added).

The Mandatory Variant can easily be selected by placing a tick in the Mandatory Variant box as shown below:

After completing the above tasks **Save** the Bookable product form.

THE MANDATORY VARIANT AND THE POS

When selecting the Variant and Quantity of the Product that has the Mandatory Variant associated to it in the POS, the quantity of the chosen Mandatory Variant will be automatically displayed as 1. Any further Variants to be purchased can then be added alongside the Mandatory Variant. It is also possible to increase the quantity of the Mandatory Variant if this is applicable. The Mandatory Variant is highlighted in the example below.
